Our scholars have also made it clear—they need safe spaces to have fun and enjoy recreation on the weekends. We hear them, and we are committed to providing more opportunities for youth to gather, connect, and simply be kids in a safe and supportive environment. Moving forward, we hope to strengthen partnerships with organizations, businesses, and schools to secure spaces where our scholars can unwind, build friendships, and engage in positive experiences outside of school and structured programming.
